2012 Ordering Suggestions: Due to a lower inventory of P+1+1's and P+2's, we will not accept orders in excess of your 2011 order OR 1,200 trees for "new customers", until after October 30th. After that, it's first come first served. A deposit is necessary with your order.

Canaan Fir Seed Availability, 2012 version: Last year we foolishly predicted some harvestable Canaan seed but actual seed amounts were disappointing. Once again betting on Mother Nature, we see an abundant cone crop as of late June. The actual seed poundage and germination percentages will be subject to whims of Mother Nature.

Canaan Fir Seed Sources: All of our seed (and transplants) come from orchards established from known areas in West Virginia: Canaan Valley, Blister Swamp, Stone Coal Run and Cheat Mountain. Research by Dr. Jim Brown made possible the selection of parent trees with improved characteristics to populate our orchards in the USDA-NEWSL (WSL). Dr. Brown has also established grafted seed orchards, which will result in even better trees in the future. The Canaan Fir Tree Co. has paid The Ohio State University in excess of \$100,000 in the past 10 years to help assure a continuing supply of Canaan seed. **In 2012 all of our trees are from the Watershed Lab (WSL) (improved parent trees)!**
